Handling deposits, fees payments & refunds

Deposits

The Lord College Student makes minimum 50% payment towards his course fees and £250 as registration, which can be paid by Cheque, Bank Draft or Bank transfer.

Fees payments

Upon receipt of the deposit an unconditional offer letter is provided to the student and if he is successful in securing his visa the student pays the balance 50% in two installments mutually agreed between the college and the student.

Refunds

In an unlikely event of visa refusal the student will be refunded his initial deposit within 21 working days of receipt of all original college documents and a copy of his visa refusal. The registration fees of £250 is non refundable and adjusted towards the administrative costs.

When a local student withdraws his application, or discontinues his course within 10 days of course start the deposit is refunded and not the registration fees (this does not apply to international students who are sponsored by the college).

When a international student wishes to withdraw or discontinues his course after coming to UK on the license of the college, the regulations at that time will apply and the decision of the management will be final.

If a student withdraws before 1 month of his course start date 1 term fees is deducted and the balance is refunded.

The student is not entitled for any refunds if he discontinues his course after 1 month of the course start date.
